ORDINANCE NO. 1565

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE TRANSIENT GUEST TAX IN THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-1696 *et seq.*, (the “Act”) authorizes cities to establish a transient guest tax upon the gross receipts derived from or paid directly or through an accommodations broker by transient guests for sleeping accommodations in any hotel, motel or tourist court; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas (the “City”) has previously adopted (i) Charter Ordinance No. 7 exempting itself from certain provisions of the Act and establishing certain replacement provisions therefor, and (ii) Ordinance No. 641, which previously established a transient guest tax in the amount of five percent (5%) of the gross rental receipts derived from or paid by transient guests for sleeping accommodations, exclusive of charges for incidental services or facilities, in any hotel, motel or tourist court within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary and desirable to increase the transient guest tax to six percent (6%) of the gross rental receipts derived from or paid by transient guests for sleeping accommodations, exclusive of charges for incidental services or facilities, in any hotel, motel or tourist court within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Transient Guest Tax. Commencing April 1, 2014, the transient guest tax established by Ordinance No. 641 of the City is hereby increased to six percent (6%) of the gross rental receipts derived from or paid by transient guests for sleeping accommodations, exclusive of charges for incidental services or facilities, in any hotel, motel or tourist court within the City.

SECTION 2. No Other Modifications. Nothing in this Ordinance shall delete or modify any other matters contained in Ordinance No. 641 of the City, and except as may be specifically set forth in this Ordinance, all of the provisions of Ordinance No. 641 of the City shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Notification. The City Clerk shall notify the Kansas Department of Revenue of this Ordinance by causing said Department to receive this Ordinance (or a certified copy thereof) on or before February 28, 2014.


