ORDINANCE NO. 1569

AN ORDINANCE (1) AMENDING SECTION 4-511.2 OF CHAPTER IV, ARTICLE 5 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, (2) ADDING SECTIONS 4-1603(bb) OF CHAPTER IV, ARTICLE 16 OF SAID CODE, AND (3) AMENDING SECTION 100(B)(8) OF ARTICLE 6 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER ZONING REGULATIONS, AS PREVIOUSLY INCORPORATED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1187 OF THE CITY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLARIFYING THE DESCRIPTION OF SUITABLE BARRIERS FOR RESIDENTIAL SWIMMING POOLS.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas (the "City") has a stand-alone "Building Code", but has also previously amended the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas (the "Code"), so as to incorporate by reference both (1) the "International Building Code, 2006 Edition" (the "IBC") and (2) the "International Residential Code, 2006 Edition" (the "IRC"), each with certain deletions, modifications and additions, all as set forth in the Code; and

WHEREAS, by its Ordinance No. 1187 adopted September 24, 2002 and published in the Official City Newspaper on October 3, 2002, the City adopted the "Zoning Regulations of the City of Andover, Kansas" (the "Zoning Regulations"), including Sections 101(C) of Article 1, 104(A) & (E) of Article 3, and 100(B)(8) of Article 6, all relating to the definition of fences and their necessity.

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary and desirable to repeal and amend certain provisions of its existing Code (including the IRC) and the Zoning Regulations, in order to conform the differing requirements and remove existing inconsistencies throughout the Code on the topic of swimming pool barriers; and

WHEREAS, following a duly noticed and held public hearing, the City of Andover Planning Commission has recommended approval of this Ordinance to correct these inconsistencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Repeal and Replacement of Section 4-511.2. Section 4.511.2 of Chapter IV, Article 5 of the Code entitled "Enclosures." is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

4-511.2. Enclosures and Covers. Outdoor swimming pools, hot tubs and spas, containing water more than 24 inches (610 mm) in depth shall be completely surrounded by a fence or barrier at least 48 inches (1219 mm) in height above the finished ground level measured on the side of the barrier away from the pool. Gates and doors in such barriers shall be self-closing and self-latching. Where the self-latching device is less than 54 inches (1372 mm) above the bottom of the gate, the release mechanism shall be located on the pool side of the gate. Self-closing and self-latching gates shall be maintained such that the gate will positively close and latch when released from an open position of 6 inches (152 mm) from the gatepost. No existing pool enclosure shall be removed, replaced or changed in a manner that reduces its effectiveness as a safety barrier.

Hot tubs and spas with a safety cover, which safety cover in each case complies with ASTM F 1346, shall be exempt from the fence or barrier requirements of foregoing paragraph. Provided that, any such cover shall be operated and maintained in a manner which will not reduce its effectiveness as a safety device. Such a cover shall not be removed, replaced or changed in a manner that reduces its effectiveness as a safety device without complying with the fence or barrier requirements of the foregoing paragraph.

SECTION 2. Dwelling Unit As Barrier. The City's incorporating reference to the IRC is hereby amended by inserting the following Subsection (bb) at the end of Section 4-1603 of Chapter 4, Article 16 of the Code:

(bb) Subsection AG105.2(9) of Appendix G (separating the wall of a dwelling unit from the general definition of barrier) is hereby deleted, and dwelling units shall be considered a part of the recognized barrier.

Nothing in this Section 2 shall delete or modify any other matters, as may be set forth or described elsewhere in the International Residential Code and not specifically referenced herein.

SECTION 3. Amendment of Zoning Regulations. The Zoning Regulations are hereby amended by deleting the existing Subsection 100(B)(8) of Article 6 describing Permitted Accessory Uses and substituting the following:

8. Storm shelters, children's playhouses, statuary, arbors, trellises, barbecue stoves, flagpoles, fences, walls, bathhouses and permanent-type swimming pools.

Nothing in this Section 3 shall delete or modify any other matters contained in the Zoning Regulations.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and

either (a) publication once in the official newspaper of the City, or (b) publication of a summary of this Ordinance certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney.

On April 29, 2014, the City of Andover, Kansas adopted Ordinance No. 1569, which amends Section 4-511.2 of the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas, adds Sections 4-1603(bb) to the Code and amends Section 100(B)(8) of Article 6 of the Andover Zoning Regulations, so as conform to the International Residential Code for the purpose of clarifying the description of suitable barriers for residential swimming pools.
