ORDINANCE NO. 1579

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE “STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES,” EDITION OF 2014; AND AMENDING CHAPTER XVIII, ARTICLE 1, SECTIONS 18-101, 18-102, 18-103 AND 18-302 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. §12-3009 *et seq.*, and K.S.A. 12-3301 *et seq.*, all as amended, the City of Andover, Kansas (the “City”) desires to incorporate by reference the “Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities” (the “STO”), with certain deletions, modifications and additions, as set forth in the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas (the “Code”); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Code to reflect incorporation of the 2014 Edition of the STO (the “2014 STO”); and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City finds it advisable to incorporate the 2014 STO by reference and to amend the Code to reflect incorporation of the 2014 STO.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, BUTLER COUNTY, STATE OF KANSAS:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance incorporating the 2014 STO supersedes and repeals Ordinance No. 1552, the ordinance that incorporated the 2014 STO, and any and all previous ordinances similar thereto or the incorporating previous editions thereof.

SECTION 2. The City hereby incorporates by reference the “Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities,” 2014 Edition, with the certain deletions as set forth in Section 3 below. Accordingly, Section 18-101 of the Code is hereby amended to read, as follows:

18-101. Standard traffic ordinance incorporated.

Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-3009 *et seq.*, and K.S.A. 12-3301 *et seq.*, the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, 2014 Edition, as prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas (the “2014 STO”), is hereby adopted by reference, as if said model or standard ordinance were set out in full herein, save and accept such sections, parts, or portions as may be omitted or deleted, modified, or changed elsewhere within the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas.

SECTION 3. The 2014 STO, adopted by reference by the City of Andover, Kansas, shall be modified by deleting Subsection 33(a), and Section 18-102 of the Code shall be accordingly amended to read, as follows:

18-102. Deletions. Subsection 33 (a) relating to Maximum Speed Limits is hereby deleted from the 2014 STO with substitute provisions having been enacted at Section 18-201 and 18-202 of the Code.

Nothing in this Section 3 shall delete or modify any other existing traffic ordinances, as may be set forth or specifically described elsewhere in the Code and not specifically referenced herein.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to maintain no fewer than three (3) copies of the 2014 STO to be made available for public inspection at all reasonable office hours. The City Clerk shall place a sticker on all copies stating “Official Copy as adopted by the Code of the City of Andover, by Ordinance No. 1579.” The City Clerk’s office shall, in each of the 2014 STO copies, place a sticker reflecting the deletions from the 2014 STO as set forth in Section 3 above and paste a copy this Ordinance inside the back cover. Section 18-103 of the Code shall be accordingly amended to read, as follows:

18-103. Copies.

The City Clerk of Andover, Kansas shall prepare and make three (3) copies of the 2014 STO, by marking or stamping thereon “Official Copy as Incorporated by Ordinance No. 1579. With all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted clearly marked to show any such omission and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspections and available to the public at all reasonable business hours.

SECTION 5. Section 18-302 of the Code is hereby amended to read, as follows:

18-302. Same; times, days, speed.

As described in the referenced subsections of 18-301, maximum speed limitations for designated school zones shall be in force during the following times:

(a) (d) (e): Such school zone shall be in force from 7:20 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 2:25 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday of each week when school is in session.

(b) (c) (f) (g) (h): Such school zones shall be in force from 8:10 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. and from 3:10 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. Monday through Friday of each week when school is in session.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any street or public way designated as a school zone during the times hereinabove set forth.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and either (a) publication once in the official newspaper of the City, or (b) publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney.
