ORDINANCE NO. 1590

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF 75/100'S OF ONE PERCENT (.75%) WITHIN THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved, at an election held on the 7th day of April, 2015, the levying of a retailers' sales tax in the City of Andover, Kansas (the "City"), for not more than five (5) years for the special purpose of financing and paying the costs of a new Street Maintenance Shop, a Fire Department Ladder Truck and a new Central Park Restroom Facility, as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187 et seq. and amendments thereto, there is hereby levied a city retailers' sales tax in the amount of 75/100's of one percent (.75%) to take effect on the 1st day of October, 2015.

Section 2. Except as otherwise provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' sales tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and either (a) publication once in the official newspaper of the City, or (b) publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney, and a copy shall be duly certified and submitted to the State Director of Taxation.
