ORDINANCE NO. 1623

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 103A8 AND 103A9 OF ARTICLE 7 OF THE ZONING REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1187, PERTAINING TO POLITICAL CAMPAIGN SIGNS AND IDEOLOGICAL SIGNS; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1623 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS.

WHEREAS on September 24, 2012, the City of Andover, Kansas (the "City") enacted Ordinance No. 1187, which Ordinance was duly published and which provided for the adoption of an incorporation therein of certain Zoning Regulations for said City (the "Zoning Regulations"), official copies of same being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City has, after giving due notice, held a public hearing on July 19, 2016 and made certain recommendations for amendments to the Zoning Regulations as contained herein; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City desires to approve such amendments to the Zoning Regulations in accordance therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 103A8 of Article 7 pertaining to exemptions for political campaign signs is hereby deleted.

Section 2. That Section 103A9 of Article 7 pertaining to exemptions for ideological signs is hereby deleted.

Section 3. Any provisions of this Ordinance which shall be declared to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid shall not affect the validity and authority of the other sections of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 1623 adopted by the governing body of the City on August 9, 2016 is hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and either (a) publication once in the official newspaper of the City, or (b) publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney.


