ORDINANCE NO. 1631

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CANDIDACY FOR CITY OFFICES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, BUTLER COUNTY, STATE OF KANSAS.

Section 1. Section 6-101, Chapter VI, Article I. of the Code of the City of Andover is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

6-101. Candidacy for City Offices; Conduct of elections.

Elections for City office shall be non-partisan. Any person desiring to become a candidate for an elected city office shall file such declaration of candidacy and pay any fee as required by Kansas law. If Kansas law requires a nomination petition, it must be signed by at least one (1) qualified elector of the City. Except as otherwise set forth in this Code and Charter Ordinances of the City, the candidacy and election of city officials shall be conducted in all respects as provided by the laws of Kansas governing the holding of city elections.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on and be in full force after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and either (a) publication once in the official newspaper of the City, or (b) publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney.
