ORDINANCE NO. 1651

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE “STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES,” EDITION OF 2017; AND AMENDING CHAPTER XVIII, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 18-302 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. §8-1560, as amended, the City of Andover, Kansas (the “City”) desires to modify certain maximum speed modifications and additions to the “Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities,” Edition of 2017 (the “STO”), as previously set forth in the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas (the “Code”); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Code to reflect such modifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, BUTLER COUNTY, STATE OF KANSAS:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance deletes and repeals Section 18-302 of the Code, enacted by Section 5 of Ordinance No. 1579, as a partial modification of deleted Section 33 of the STO, of the City.

SECTION 2. Section 18-302 of the Code is hereby amended to read, as follows:

18-302. Same; times, days, speed.

As described in the referenced subsections of 18-301, maximum speed limitations for designated school zones shall be in force during such times in which students are normally en route to or from school (as determined by the Chief of Police in coordination with school officials) during the days of the week when school is in session. Enforcement times shall be indicated by visible time posting or flashing yellow light placed at the commencement of such school zones. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any street or public way designated as a school zone during the posted times or when such signal is flashing as hereinabove set forth.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to place a sticker on any and all copies of the STO reflecting the amendment to STO and paste a copy of this Ordinance inside the back cover thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and either (a) publication

once in the official newspaper of the City, or (b) publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney.
