Mr. Constantino stated that staff reviewed the revised landscape plan and the revisions meet the landscaping specifications required in the Unified Development Manual (UDM).

Mr. Allison asked about the gray-shaded areas surrounding the plantings on the landscape plan. Mr. Woolsoncroft stated that the gray area will be decorative rock mulch installed over weed barrier fabric.

Mr. Allison asked about the type of buffer that would be used along the eastern property line. Mr. Mangus stated that the subject property is buffered by a wood fence.

Todd Woolsoncroft made a motion to approve the revised Andover Rental Center landscape plan. Motion seconded by Homer Henry. Motion carried 4/0.
