

ORDINANCE NO. 1500

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-201 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS DEALING WITH THE APPOINTMENT OF CITY OFFICERS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1-201(a) of the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

“The Mayor, at the first regular meeting of the Council in May of each year shall appoint, by and with the consent of the Council, a City Clerk, a Treasurer, a Municipal Judge, a Chief of Police, a City Attorney, a City Engineer, a City Prosecutor and any other officers deemed necessary, whose offices are hereafter provided by Ordinance. All such officers shall qualify in the manner and shall have and perform the duties required by this and other Ordinances of the City and the laws of Kansas. Every appointment to office, and the date thereof, shall be entered on the journal of proceedings of the Council.”

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in the official city newspaper and shall repeal and take the place of Section 1-201(a) of the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas.
