I. Purpose

The purpose of this General Order is to specify the department's responsibilities in areas where concurrent jurisdiction with other law enforcement agencies exist within the city limits of Andover.

II. Policy

Members of the department will foster an attitude of cooperation in areas of the City where concurrent law enforcement jurisdiction exists by cooperating with those law enforcement agencies sharing jurisdiction.

III. Definitions

A. Concurrent Jurisdiction: Geographic locations where two or more law enforcement agencies have jurisdiction to exercise law enforcement authority.

V. Procedures

A. Geographical Boundaries

1. An official map showing the current city limits of the department's jurisdiction will be displayed in the Squad Room (LE 2.1.1; COM 2.3.1a).
2. An electronic map showing the current city limits will be maintained in the Communications Section Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) computer (LE 2.1.1; COM 2.3.1b).
3. The Operations Commander, or designee, will ensure the map in the squad room is updated following any annexation.
4. The Communications Director, or designee, will ensure the map in CAD is updated following any annexation.

5. All members should keep up to date with any changes in boundaries of the city limits.
6. In a call for police service where Communications personnel are unable to quickly determine jurisdiction, officers of the department shall be dispatched and the uncertainty shall be resolved at a later time.

B. Concurrent Jurisdiction (LE 2.1.2; COM 2.3.2)

1. With the exception of the Butler Community College campuses, the department will have primary law enforcement jurisdiction within the city limits of Andover, Kansas.
2. Butler Community College Department of Safety will have primary jurisdiction on the college's campuses located in Andover, Kansas. Officers dispatched to take a report for an incident occurring on one of the college's campuses should refer the report to Department of Safety. Members should provide any assistance requested by the Department of Safety, including the taking of the report if a Department of Safety officer is unavailable or unable to be contacted.
3. The Butler County Sheriff's Office, Kansas Highway Patrol, Kansas Bureau of Investigation and other State law enforcement agencies have concurrent jurisdiction within the city limits of Andover, Kansas and may initiate law enforcement action within the city limits. Members of the department will cooperate fully with requests for assistance from one of these agencies taking law enforcement action within the department's jurisdiction.
